### On Admission for the Bachelor of Arts Program in Service Innovation (International Program) for an Academic Year 2020 (B.E. 2563)

College of Innovation, Thammasat University

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#### 1. Campus

All the classes for the Bachelor of Arts Program in Service Innovation (International Program) (BSI) will be held at Thammasat University Tha Prachan campus.

#### 2. Eligibility Requirements

2.1 Thai applicants who have or expect to receive a high school certificate or its equivalent must have:

2.1.1 A minimum GPAX as follows.

Portfolio 1 (1 <sup>st</sup> round)	Program Admission 1 (2 <sup>nd</sup> round)	Program Admission 2 (3 <sup>rd</sup> round)
GPAX - 3.00	GPAX - 2.50	GPAX - 2.00

2.1.2 A minimum score from one of the following English Proficiency Tests.

TOEFL (PBT/ITP)	500
TOEFL (CBT)	173
TOEFL (IBT)	61
IELTS	6.0
TU-GET	500
TU-GET (CBT)	61

The score must not be more than two years old.

In the case of lower English test score than a minimum requirement indicated above, the College might consider if an applicant has outstanding qualifications, for example, an excellent academic performance or having paper published in international conference/journal. However, the minimum score of English Proficiency Test must not be lower than the following criteria.

TOEFL (PBT/ITP)	450
TOEFL (CBT)	133
TOEFL (IBT)	45
IELTS	5.0
TU-GET	450
TU-GET (CBT)	45

The score must not be more than two years old.

**2.2 Thai applicants who graduated from international school in Thailand or overseas, and all non-Thai students must have:**

2.2.1 A High School Equivalency Certificate/ Academic Transcript. The equivalency of high school qualifications must follow the criteria as indicated in Thammasat University's Announcement on Thammasat University's Guidelines on Equivalency of High School Qualifications, 2562 B.E.

The applicant must also have a minimum GPAX as follows.

GPAX - 3.00	GPAX - 2.50	GPAX - 2.00

2.2.2 A minimum score from one of English Proficiency Tests as indicated in item 2.1.2.

### 3. Application Conditions

3.1 Successful applicants must confirm their acceptance for studies via the Clearing House System of the Thai University Central Admission System (TCAS).

3.2 If there is an evidence shown later that the applicant's qualification does not meet the requirements or the applicant provides fraudulent information, his/her application will be rejected. No application fee will be refund.
